



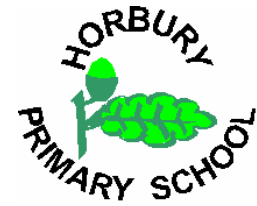

Parking The school council are going to begin to patrol the parking of cars in and around school.
