



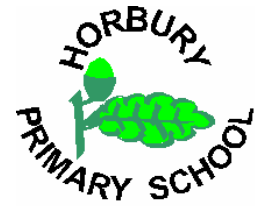

Safety

Thank you for your understanding with regard to leaving your child at the outside doors. Adults and older children dropping off their child or brother or sister must not come into the school building. The government has issued us with very strict guidelines with regard to safety and therefore if we were inspected by Ofsted and adults were in our school building without coming through the office and being supervised then we would be seen as an unsafe school. If you need to see the teacher at the start or end of the school day then you must come to the office.

Please can I also remind everyone that cars must not come on to the school campus except to drop off for breakfast club and to pick up from after school club. Dogs must not be brought on to the school campus.
