



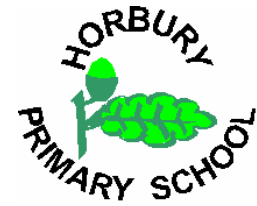

Whole School Reward System

From September, we will be introducing a new whole school reward system. At Horbury Primary School, our positive behaviour approach is very much about caring relationships and rewarding good work, manners and behaviour. We feel this will play a huge role in our

children leaving us and growing into ambitious, polite, caring citizens.

At the start of each academic year each child will start collecting points/tokens/stamps to achieve their awards. Throughout that year, the children will have the opportunity to gain their Bronze, Silver and Gold awards for that year group. At the start of each year, children will return to Bronze.

The children will be presented with their certificate in our Friday Celebration Assembly.

Each year group will have a different method of gaining their awards and this will be explained to your child by their new teacher. For example, in Year 3 children will be collecting stamps and in Year 2 children will be collecting gold nuggets.

Dinner Money From September, dinner money will be going up to £1.60 per day, or £8 per week.

Please send your child's money in a named envelope showing their class, that the money is for dinners and the amount enclosed. Please send it in on a Monday morning.
